Unit 19 • Session 6 JESUS CAME TO BE THE SACRIFICE FOR SIN Hebrews 10

WHAT DID JESUS DO TO SAVE US? JESUS LIVED A SINLESS LIFE, DIED ON THE CROSS, AND ROSE FROM THE DEAD.

God first gave the Israelites His law through Moses so that they could understand that God is holy. The law showed that people are sinners. The law could not save the people. The people offered sacrifices for their sins. But they were still guilty.

Jesus came to be the ultimate sacrifice for sin. He came to do God's plan, ending the old way of sacrifices by offering Himself as the perfect sacrifice—once and for all.


The priests stood day after day, offering the same sacrifices. But those sacrifices never took away sins. But Jesus came to offer Himself one time. Then He sat down at the right hand of God. With one sacrifice, Jesus takes away the sin of everyone who trusts in Him.

Because God forgives our sin, we no longer need to make a sacrifice to pay for sins.

God calls us to live in a way that honors Him. Jesus' blood has made the way for us to have hearts that are clean and without guilt. Jesus makes us pure when we have faith in Him.

We can help one another do what is right by loving others and doing good works. We can meet together and encourage one another because one day, Jesus will come again.

Christ Connection: Jesus came to be the sacrifice for sin. He lived a sinless life, died on the cross, and rose from the dead. In Him, we have complete forgiveness once and for all.
