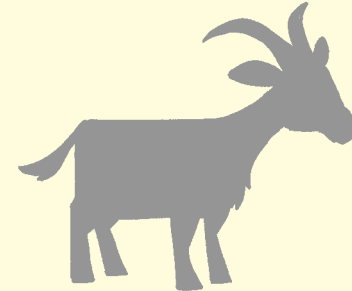
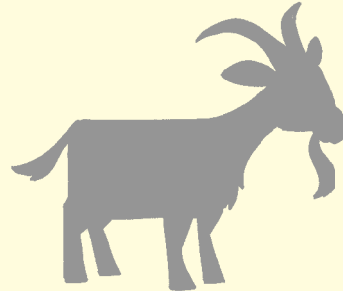
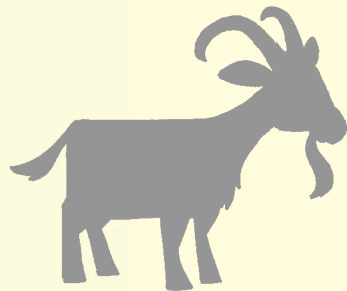
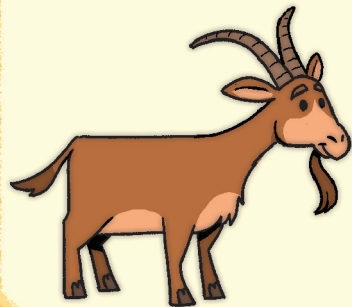
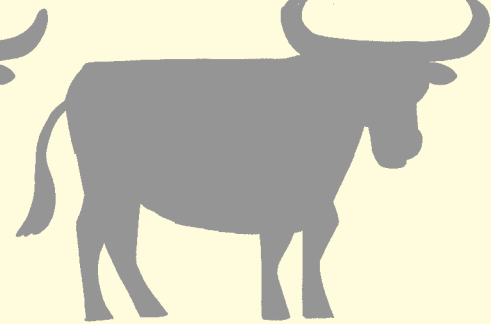
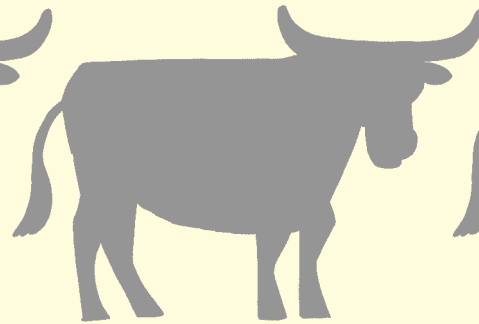
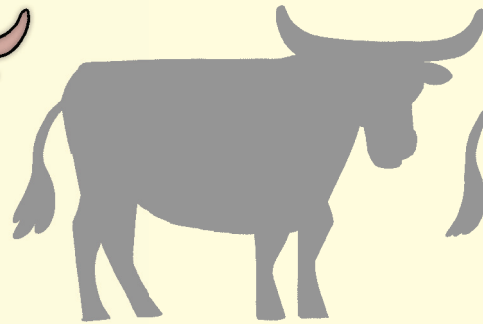
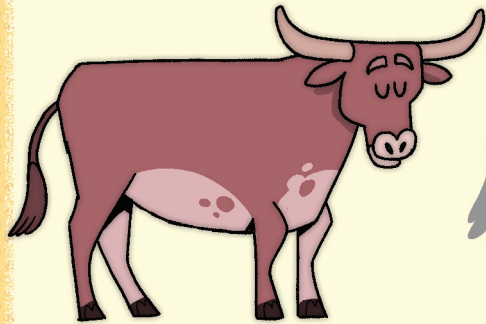
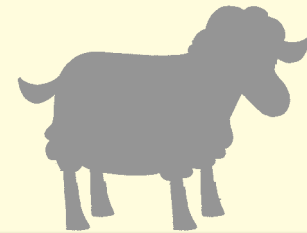
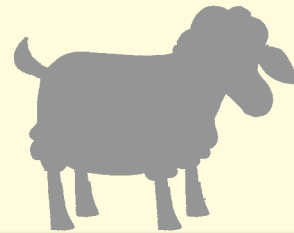
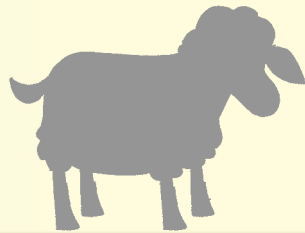
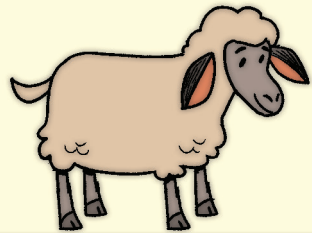
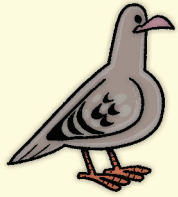


Shadow Match
